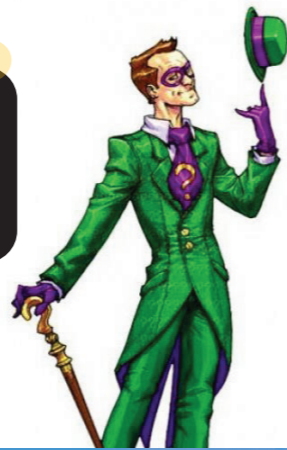


The Puzzler Page
